



Dear Community Water System Managers/Leaders and WI-AWWA Members,

A couple years ago, I was designated by WI-AWWA leadership to serve as a representative on the DNR [PFAS External Advisory Group](#) (EAG), a stakeholder forum for the DNR to solicit constructive feedback on PFAS initiatives in Wisconsin and to share stakeholder perspectives. Recently I volunteered to serve on the Cost Work Group – a subcommittee of the PFAS EAG – to identify the range of costs and potential funding sources to address PFAS contamination in drinking water supplies. **We are compiling information about the costs to identify, study, treat, and dispose of PFAS.** Some communities like Madison, Wausau, and Marshfield, for example, have direct experience addressing PFAS in drinking water. Other communities may be just starting their PFAS journey. The goal of this survey is to tabulate comprehensive costs for PFAS investigation, response, and treatment to share with DNR staff and other municipal and community water system partners.

Please follow the link and complete the survey to help us compile PFAS-related costs your community has incurred or plans to incur in each of the following areas, understanding that you might not have costs for each category. Please provide whatever information you can. If a category does not apply, please respond “N/A”. Please submit the completed survey by no later than Wednesday, September 10.

**NOTE:** Complete all seven pages of the survey if your community has found PFAS at your community water system and it has taken action or plans to take action to remediate it. Otherwise, please complete only page 1 and page 7 since the other questions will not apply to your system.
